Shall sections in Chapters III through VI be amended to grant the Town Council the authority to designate the same independent accountant to annually audit the books and accounts of the Town; to appoint members to boards, commissions, and offices within the same timeframe despite changes in the days of certain months; to remove members of appointive boards, commissions, committees or agencies for cause; to join a Health District in addition to appointing a Director of Health; and to delete the term provision for the Zoning Enforcement Officer?

Shall §§ C2-4, C3-5, C4-2, and various sections in Chapter IX be amended to provide the Town Manager and Town Council the flexibility to adjust the fiscal year and budget timeline; to extend the date by which elected persons start office from the day after the election to the Tuesday following the election; and to adjust the deadlines for certain aspects of the budget process?

Shall §§ C9-4, C9-14, C9-15, and C9-16 be amended to allow the Town Manager to include itemized estimates of actual expenditures for each department, office, agency, or activity for up to the last three completed fiscal years in his or her proposed budget; to allow the Town Manager to move funds between departments up to 3 % without the need of Town Council approval; to allow the Council to appropriate funds up to an aggregate of 1/2 of 1% of the General Fund Budget; to conform the Charter to current practices used by the Town employees; and to require that estimated tax ramifications and fiscal impacts be included in the explanatory text at budget referendum?
